MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Mackinaw Township Board was called to order at 6:00 P. M. on April 27, 2010 at 10595 Wallick Road, Mackinaw City, Michigan. Supervisor Dean led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of March 9, 2010 approved as presented.

Attorney MacArthur gave a thorough review of current situation with the tax issues with the Crossings. He reviewed information concerning Appraisal Reports and the different amounts in these reports. Attorney MacArthur will keep the Board members apprised of any new developments as it might be necessary for a Special Board meeting to comply with time lines involved.
