The regular meeting of the Mackinaw Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Falor at 7:00 P.M. on July 15. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call: Present: Keck, Falor, Brew, Williams. Absent: Ostwald. Also present: Lavender, Linda Gwilt. Agenda approved with addition of Election Worker approval under New Business.

Unfinished Business consisted of current status of Liquor control inspections. Richard Miller has reported that he is not able to continue at the current offered payment. Keck reported that he has been in contact with the Mackinaw City Village Police Department. Motion by Brew, second by Williams to authorize Keck to contract with Police Department in Mackinaw City for amount of \$800.00 per year if agreed by both parties. All aye, motion approved.

Falor reviewed Clean/Up Day as reported in her Supervisor Report. There are several things which might be considered for changes in the plan for future Clean/Up. There were a total of 55 residents that took advantage of the free Clean/Up Day.

Treasurer's Report accepted as presented. Warrant List for July approved on motion by Brew, second by Williams. Roll Call: Aye: Falor, Keck, Williams, Brew. Absent: Ostwald.

Payment for Wallick Road in August – Motion by Brew, second by Williams to approve payment to Cheboygan County Road Commission in August. Roll Call: Aye: Brew, Williams, Keck, Falor. Absent: Ostwald.

Falor reported a bid has been received for repairs on Stimpson Road. This will be tabled for future consideration.

Gwilt briefly addressed the Board Members concerning Wallick Road.
